Mr. Heer stated there have been ongoing issues with the County's ability to maintain its infrastructure. There is no consistent coordinated approach in place to maintain the buildings in a safe manner. It was also concluded that there is no functional inventory assessment program, which is a part of preventive maintenance. The efforts that departments have taken to do work on their buildings are not integrated with the County-wide VFA (County software package used to know what the needs are) system. Mr. Heer indicated the County needs to commit to a comprehensive property management system.

Supervisor Borkowski requested a breakdown of construction on all County buildings.

The Chairman directed that a report be brought back in six months on the progress of the inspections, recommendations for the 2012 Budget, and a list of all 902 County buildings.
