3) Considering the County Board's imposed obligation to approve the Mental Health Board's (MHB) BHD budget, will the Board get an opportunity to review the BHD budget, or will it just be reflected as a line item in the overall budget? If it is found that the Board does not get to review BHD's budget prior to passage, as the Board's representation, does Corporation Counsel intend to challenge that aspect of the Act?

4) Will MHB have to adhere to the County's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise requirements?
